Meyer Najem Construction Wins Four ABC Awards

(Fishers, IN) October 6, 2010 - The Associated Builders and Contractors of Indiana has awarded Meyer Najem Construction the Award of Excellence for the Brownsburg High School Senior Academy and the Phi Delta Theta Fraternity House at Butler University. Meyer Najem earned the Award of Honor for the Clarian West ED Expansion / Third Floor Build-Out project in Avon. In addition, Meyer Najem also received the Safety Award at the banquet, which recognizes our extensive Safety program. Only one contractor per year receives this prestigious award.

The Brownsburg High School Senior Academy is a new three-story 62,000-square-foot facility for seniors that connects to the northwest side of the high school and was designed to help seniors prepare for life after high school. The new facility has a capacity for 800 students and 22 classrooms.

The Phi Delta Theta Fraternity house on the Butler University campus is a 33-bed, 10,000-square-foot project consisting of a complete renovation to the 1929 structure. It is the first LEED certified fraternity house in the State of Indiana. The interior was completely gutted back to concrete floors and brick walls to allow for all new interior framing, finishes, heating, air conditioning, fire sprinklers, and electrical systems. The entire limestone exterior was patched and repaired, new windows installed, and a membrane roof was added.

The Clarian West ED Expansion / Third Floor Build-Out consist of 28,000 square feet, and third floor shell space build-out that allows the single unit floor to now operate as two individual units. The 22,000-square-foot build out includes a new air handling unit, 16 medical/surgery rooms, nine (9) postpartum and five (5) flex rooms along with levels 1 and 2 nurseries. The Intensive Care Unit (ICU) renovations include 6,000 square feet of electrical system upgrades to the ICU and Patient Care Unit rooms.
